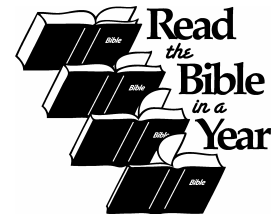


Sunday Morning Bible Study

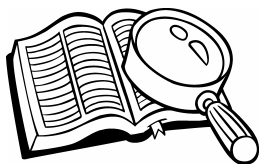

NOTE: A Braille worker has produced beautiful cards from flowers and Braille materials. She has new cards suitable for Easter. Donations go to support the Braille ministry.

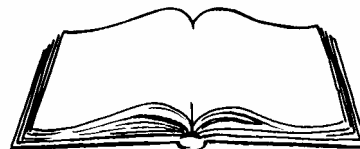


Weekday Bible Studies

Seder Meal Come and Join Us

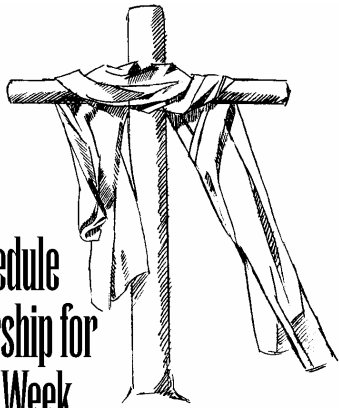

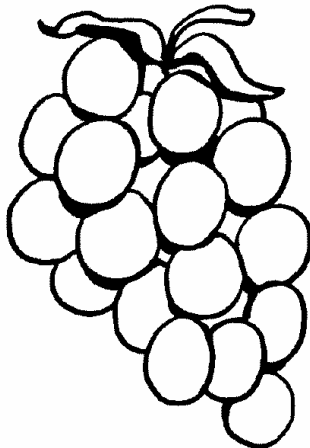

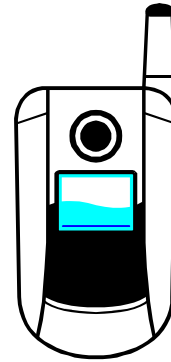
Abiding Savior Seniors

Cell Phones

How many old cell phones do you have laying around taking up space? What good are they doing? Now you have a convenient place to take them and put them to productive use.

During March, Abiding Savior Church and School are collecting **cell phones** for **Laura's House** in South Orange County. Laura's House is a non-profit organization that prevents and reduces the incidence of domestic and family violence through shelter and support programs, education, and outreach. Our collection assists Laura's House in two ways. One is to receive a monetary donation for each used cell phone donated which helps to raise essential funds for their programs. Secondly phones are reprogrammed for use by domestic violence victims as 911 phones – so they are never without help.

None of the phones end up in landfills – they either get recycled in an environmentally responsible manor or reprogrammed for reuse! This is a great and easy way to support Laura's House, so that they can continue to help the thousands of families who rely on them right here in Orange County each year.
